#### 16. General indications

#### a) Paddock

It is prohibited to bring animals in to the event area. It is prohibited for children or people without a driving licence to use vehicles. It is prohibited to use skateboards or similar forms of transport as it is the use of vehicles which have not been insured, although they are required to be insured in accordance with German regulations.

b) Environmental protection and noise reduction

It is absolutely prohibited by the authorities to run engines at the following times:

Thursday, 14th September before 8:30 and after 18:00 before 8:30 and after 18:00 before 8:30 and after 18:00 before 8:30 and after 18:30 before 8:30 and after 18:30 before 8:00 and after 18:00

The Nürburgring Betriebsgesellschaft mbH and the organizer actively protect the environment throughout all areas of their respective organizations. They also expect the participants and all concerned to comply with environmental protection. Adherence to all current legal requirements regarding the environment is a basis for business. This applies in particular to regulations on waste disposal, protection of the ground and water and protection from emissions. Any party not adhering to these regulations is damaging the reputation of motor sport in public. The current requirements set down by the Nürburgring Betriebsgesellschaft mbH in the notice "Notes for environmental protection" are binding.

Current environmental stipulations as set down by the DMSB and the Race Course (Nürburgring) will be enclosed with the confirmation of entry. These stipulations must be adhered to.

#### c) Fuel-Filling

It is not allowed to store more than 240 litres of fuel in one box at any time. While filling up the car in the box it is mandatory to use a drip pan to absorb potentially dripping fuel.
