Safety Belts

The Stewards remind all competitors of the provisions of Article 120 of the Blancpain GT Series 2018 Sporting Regulations, which states that:

"A driver coming into the pits cannot unfasten his safety harness or racing net until his car is completely stopped in front of the pit garage. After a pit stop, the car can only start moving after the driver's safety harness and racing net have been fastened. It is the car controller's responsibility to ensure that a driver is properly buckled in before the car leaves its working area to enter the track."

The Stewards also remind competitors of the provisions of International Sporting Code Appendix L Chapter III Article 4 which states that:

"Drivers must be properly restrained in their seat by safety belts in conformity with the technical regulations for the vehicle concerned, at all times during a competition when it is mobile on a circuit, pit lane, special stage or competition course."

For the avoidance of doubt, the Stewards advise all competitors that they will consider a driver who unfastens, releases or loosens his seat belts in any way while the vehicle is still in motion, in the pit lane or elsewhere on the track, to no longer be properly restrained in his seat by his safety belts.
