



GENERAL INFORMATION



- Sporting Notes 1, 2 in preparation about the air lance
- No cars in the pit lane during Q & R of other Series
- Incidents involving different categories, the more PRO Cat will be deemed to be at fault unless evidence clearly shows the contrary.
- Wheels (warm tyres) to the grid before pit lane closes
- Pit gantry cameras mandatory recording during pit stops
- Nobody in front of the car or standing behind the panels use lollipops
- Flashing head lights Max 3 times between two corners
- Speed in the pit lane!
- Gravel on track

Silver cup: Define D1, D2 & D3

- If 3 sessions - Av T1, T2 & T3 - Q ranking = 1

- If 2 sessions - Av TWO Times - Q ranking = 2

- If 1 session - Remaining time - Q ranking = 3

- If No time - Q ranking = 4

QR - Av time - Fastest individual time

FAST LANE OPEN



- Max 5' before session.
- FAST LANE OPEN
- On the timing monitors and RD radio
- Cars allowed to Pit Exit
- Not for the race
- In case of Red flag Stop in front of your Pit - Nobody in fast lane

MANDATORY PIT STOP MIN TIME



Art 153-158 tyre & driver change may happen during refuelling

Minimum time = 70 seconds

Pit lane: 418 m = 30" Min refuelling: 37" Stop&Go: 3"

+/-1 sec - ONCE Penalty: drive through

Art 67 - Bulletin from the stewards







REFUELLING



In pit lane - **only with fuel rig**. Engine OFF. Car electrically earthed on the wheels.

Max 2 fuel attendants (red armband - helmets with a visor)

1 'fire' attendant - Min 5 kg extinguisher

1 mechanic wash/clean, assist driver during tyre change (windscreen, lights, radiator grille, water bottle)

"dead man" (fuel flow shut-off valve at the refuelling tower - fireproof overalls and with a helmet)

"vent man" refuelling valve on opposite side of the car.

'tyre' & 'brake' Tech (ext to the team) visual checks – t° probe or pressure gauge






Figure 1b: GT3 position




Figure 2: Ring nut with control vamish








PIT ENTRY SPEED LIMIT LINE





























NEW FORMATION LAP












- Speed 80 Km/Hr NO Zig Zag
- SC always preceded by FCY except during the three $1^{\rm st}$ laps
- SC gets the leader during the FCY
- Countdown
 - At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
 - At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
 - Green flag on short notice GREEN

SAFETY CAR







PROCEDURE



Slow down to 80 Km/Hr NO overtaking

Free practices: Clock will NOT stop - go to pit lane

During Qualifying: Clock stops - go to pit lane

During the race: Clock stop - line up red line

- Order as when the red flag was declared
- Teams and officials ONLY
- Parc-Fermé conditions Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later
