

Facts: Alleged contact between cars 11 and 31 on lap 7.
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 52 of the Blancpain GT Series 2018 Sporting Regulations
Decision: No action appropriate
Reason: The Stewards have investigated the incident report received. The Race Director reports that there is no circuit or TV video footage of the alleged incident but the Stewards have viewed on-board video footage from car #31. The Stewards find there is no evidence to support the allegation of contact between these two cars and therefore determine that no further action is appropriate.
