ERRATA AND CLARIFICATIONS

The following errata and clarifications to the 2018 Sporting Regulations, released during the Monza round of the Blancpain GT Series Endurance Cup as Sporting Note #2, also apply to the Blancpain GT Series Sprint Cup

Article 155

To place or remove the air hose to the air jacks, teams may either use one of the two tyre mechanics or a third mechanic, who may be the one charged with cleaning the windscreen or helping the drivers.

One mechanic, without an armband, may bring and connect the air hose to the air jacks. Once the wheels have been changed, the hose must be removed by the same mechanic in order to bring the car down. No other system may be used to bring the car down onto its wheels. Connecting and removing the air hose may also be performed by one of the tyre mechanics with a red armband.
