The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 26 / Markus Winkelhock

Competitor: Sainteloc Junior Team

Time: 17:29 hrs

Session: Race

Facts: The driver caused a collision with car #77.


Offence: Breach of Article 52 of the Blancpain GT Series 2018 Sporting Regulations

Decision: **A Stop & Go penalty equivalent to 1-lap, converted to a 1-lap penalty, and 1 Behaviour Warning Point.**

Reason: Car #26 pushed the rear of car #77 exiting turn 10, causing #77 to spin into the pit wall. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative and having viewed video evidence, the Stewards determine that driver #26 was responsible for the incident. The Stewards note that driver #26 is a Platinum grade and that the driver of #77 was Bronze grade and that car #77 was unable to continue. Therefore they impose a Stop & Go penalty equivalent to one lap in accordance with Article 50 of the Blancpain GT Series 2018 Sporting Regulations. As this is imposed after the race, this is converted to a one-lap penalty in accordance with Article 55 of the Blancpain GT Series 2018 Sporting Regulations.

The Competitor is reminded that, in accordance with Article 12.2.4 of the 2018 FIA International Sporting Code, the above penalty is not susceptible to appeal.
