

## BULLETIN No. 4 – Minimum Pit Stop Time

The Stewards notify all competitors and officials of the following:

In accordance with article 20.1.2 of the 2020 Sporting Regulations, the 2019 pit stop procedures as outlined in Appendix 14 will be used for the Imola race. Team with fuel sensors already fitted must use them, in order to test the system before they are mandatory at the second Endurance round.

In accordance with the 2020 regulations, for cars using a non-return valve, the air hose may be disconnected as soon as this is in place, and it may be released using this to bring the car down onto its wheels.

The **minimum pit stop time** from pit in to pit out will be **80 seconds (1 minute 20 seconds)**. There is a one-second tolerance which can be used once during the race.
