

GT WORLD CHALLENGE POWERED BY AWS

SPORTING BOARD DECISION #1 – 26/07/20

REQUEST FROM ENTRANT OF CARS #3 AND #9

The Sporting Board has received a request dated 25th July 2020 from the entrant of cars #3 and #9 in the 2020 GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Endurance Cup to change the licence name under which the cars are entered.

This situation is accepted as force majeure due to the disruption caused by the Covid-19 pandemic.

For the Imola event, the cars are entered under the Entrant licence Flying Lizard Motorsports (ACCUS E1302-U-20). However, noting the request from the entrant, the Sporting Board accepts that for the Nürburgring event and for the remainder of the 2020 season, the cars will be entered under the name KPAX Racing. Whilst the current licence name must remain valid until a replacement licence is issued, the Sporting Board determines that points scored under the Flying Lizard Motorsports licence will be transferred to the new entrant name as soon as this is confirmed and the licence is received by the Sporting Board.


