














- Speed 80 Km/Hr NO weaving (Zig Zag)
- FCY always followed by SC except during the three 1st laps where it will directly SC
- SC gets the leader during the FCY
- Countdown 20 seconds
 - At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
 - At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
 - RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 GREEN



- The SC will come on track during the FCY without lights.
- SC gets the leader. If necessary it will overtake cars.
- No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking
- "SAFETY CAR procedure" the SC will turn on its lights and all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC.
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure:
 - "SC in this lap"
 - "SC lights off" all signalling removed
 - "Green" -no overtaking prior to pass the line























PROCEDURE



Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking

FP and Qualifying: pit lane – to your pit

Races: Cars to line up in front of the red line

- Teams and officials ONLY
- Parc-Fermé conditions Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later

























DURING PIT WINDOW



- Back to the pit
- Parc-Fermé conditions
- Pit stop permitted when done, Parc-Fermé
- Marshals will call the cars to line up in the order "at the line of the last full lap before the opening of the pit window"
