

**GT WORLD CHALLENGE EUROPE POWERED BY AWS**

**SPORTING NOTE #9 – 23/10/2020 - CLARIFICATION OF ARTICLE 20.3**

The concept of the maximum continuous driving time for the Total 24 Hours of Spa, as explained in article 20.3 of the 2020 Sporting Regulations, is clarified as follows :

*The maximum continuous driving time per driver is three hours 15 minutes, counted from the first time that a driver crosses the pit exit line (or takes the race start) until the next time the car crosses the pit exit line with a different driver behind the wheel, not including any time spent in the pits. This will be extended by 5 minutes should a Full Course Yellow or Safety Car be in operation during the final lap of a driver's ~~this~~ last consecutive stint. After ~~this~~ any continuous driving period of three hours or more , a minimum rest period of one hour is required. No driver can drive more than 14 hours in total. A penalty will be imposed on the car of any driver who exceeds these limits or does not comply with the mandatory rest period.*


