





GT WORLD CHALLENGE EUROPE POWERED BY AWS SPORTING NOTE #9 – 23/10/2020 - CLARIFICATION OF ARTICLE 20.3

The concept of the maximum continuous driving time for the Total 24 Hours of Spa, as explained in article 20.3 of the 2020 Sporting Regulations, is clarified as follows:

The maximum continuous driving time per driver is three hours 15 minutes, counted from the first time that a driver crosses the pit exit line (or takes the race start) until the next time the car crosses the pit exit line with a different driver behind the wheel, not including any time spent in the pits. This will be extended by 5 minutes should a Full Course Yellow or Safety Car be in operation during the final lap of a driver's third last consecutive stint. After this any continuous driving period of three hours or more, a minimum rest period of one hour is required. No driver can drive more than 14 hours in total. A penalty will be imposed on the car of any driver who exceeds these limits or does not comply with the mandatory rest period.
