SPORTING NOTE #10 - 23/10/2020 - CLARIFICATION OF ARTICLE 29.8

CARRY-OVER TYRES FOR PAUL RICARD

Considering the revised 2020 calendar of the GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS, with the Paul Ricard six-hour race following the Total 24 Hours of Spa, the final paragraph of article 29.8 is amended as follows:

For the race, the number of tyres is free and exempt from any marking. However, the barcodes are registered to enable Competitors to use them as Used tyres in subsequent races. A maximum of two sets of tyres per car may be chosen to be carried over to subsequent Endurance Competitions only. There is no limit on the number of sets of used tyres which may be carried over to use in the Bronze Test (if applicable), Free Practice and Pre-Qualifying for the six-hour race of Paul Ricard. No sets of tyres registered at Spa may be carried over as new tyres for Paul Ricard.
