



# **GENERAL INFORMATION**



- No cars in the pit lane during Q & R of other Series (Pit Lane Manager)
- Incidents involving different categories, the more PRO Cat will be deemed to be at fault unless evidence clearly shows the contrary.
- Wheels (warm tyres) to the grid before pit lane closes
- Pit gantry cameras mandatory recording during pit stops Time Set correctly
- Nobody in front of the car or standing behind the panels use lollipops
- Flashing head lights Max 3 times between two corners

# REFUELLING



In pit lane - only with fuel rig. Engine OFF. Car electrically earthed.

Max 2 fuel attendants (red armband - helmets with a visor)

1 'fire' attendant – Min 5 kg extinguisher

1 mechanic wash/clean, assist driver during tyre change (windscreen, lights, radiator grid, water bottle)

"dead man" (fuel flow shut-off valve at the refuelling tower - fireproof overalls and helmet)

"vent man" (green armband) refuelling valve on opposite side of the car.

'tyre' & 'brake' Tech visual checks – t° probe or pressure gauge







Full Pit Stop: refuelling for minimum 40 seconds – with one second tolerance

<u>Short Pit Stop</u>: refuelling - maximum according to the BoP.

TBC with a steward bulletin

<u>Minimum Drive Through Time</u>: Pit lane = 418 m = 30"

Speed in the pit lane 50 Km/Hr

No slowing or stopping, except for force majeure.


Leave the working area when the car is ready to re-join the track

### (Yellow Blinking) FCY NOW - 80 Km / Hr











Speed 80 Km/Hr – NO weaving (Zig Zag)

(Yellow Blinking)

FCY followed by SC except during the three 1<sup>st</sup> laps where it will directly SC

SC gets the leader during the FCY

Countdown 20 seconds – marshalling system

- At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
- At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
- RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 GREEN







## SAFETY CAR (SC)



- The SC will come on track during the FCY without lights.
- SC gets the leader. If necessary it will overtake cars.
- No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking
- "SC procedure"


SC



- the SC will turn on its lights, all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap"
- "SC lights off" all signalling removed
  - "Green" -- no overtaking prior to pass the line







## PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC



Pit exit light remain **GREEN** 

When the SC will pass the FINISH LINE, the pit exit light will turn **RED** 

When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn **GREEN** again





## **RED FLAG PROCEDURE**



Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking – drive to pit lane

Free practices: Clock will NOT stop

Qualifying: Clock stops - lap time cancelled

- Race: Clock will NOT stop line up red line (start line) or follow the SC
  - Order as when the red flag was declared
  - Parc-Fermé conditions on the grid teams and officials ONLY
  - Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later











- At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.
- During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.
- During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.
