The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined timekeeping data, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 159 / Valentin Hasse Clot

Competitor: Garage 59

Time (fact): 15:01 hrs

Session: Pre-Qualifying


Fact: Car 159 failed to respect yellow flags at turn 5

Offence: Breach of Article 19.8 and 33.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2.5.5.b of Appendix H of the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **Drop of 3 grid positions for the Race and 1 Behaviour Warning Point**

Reason: The driver of car 159 improved his sector 2 time (and set his fastest sector 2 time of the session) while yellow flags were being waved at turn 5. The Stewards have considered timekeeping data and have heard from the driver and the competitor's representative. It was explained that the car was on new tyres, with brakes bedded in, but the driver confirmed that he saw the yellow flag and acknowledged that he should have slowed more in response. The Stewards determine that this is a breach of the above regulations, and a matter of safety, and therefore impose the penalty above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
