The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitor's representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Nos. / Drivers: 11 / Francesco Zollo and 33 / Benjamin Hites

Competitors: Kessel Racing and Rinaldi Racing

Time (fact): 11:18 hrs

Session: Qualifying 2

Fact: There was contact between cars 11 and 33 at Turn 5

Regulation: Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: There was side to side contact between cars 11 and 33 at turn 5, as car 33 moved down the inside of car 11. Having heard from driver 11 and both competitors' representatives and having viewed external and on-board video evidence, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They note that both cars continued and determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
