The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 10 / Karim Ojeh
Competitor: Boutsen Ginion Racing
Time (fact): 22:10 hrs
Session: Pre-Qualifying
Fact: Car 10 collided with the stationary car 40 when entering its pit lane working area.
Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, Article 12.2.1.h and 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Article 2d) of Appendix L Chapter IV to the Code
Decision: **Fine of €500**
Reason: When entering its pit lane working area car 10 collided with car 40, which was stationary on skates in its own working area. Having considered pit gantry camera footage and the competitor's own similar video footage, the Stewards are satisfied that this is a breach of the above regulations and, noting that there was no sporting advantage, impose a fine of €500. Whilst the driver has ultimate responsibility for his actions, the Stewards consider that the positioning of the team's car controller in this case contributed significantly to this incident and therefore do not impose a Behaviour Waring Point in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
