Reason:

Having heard from the competitor's representative, and noting that that the sector time of

car 52 was only marginally improved over the previous sector time whilst track conditions

were improving significantly, the Stewards are satisfied that the driver slowed in response to the yellow flag in this case and that no further action is appropriate.
