The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 32 / Charles Weerts  
**Competitor:** Team WRT  
**Time (fact):** 09:29 hrs  
**Session:** Qualifying 1  
**Fact:** Car 32 made contact with car 90 when waiting to join the fast lane  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 34.16 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations  
**Decision:** **No further action**  
**Reason:** Car 32 made slight contact with car 90 while trying to join the fast lane. Having heard from both competitors' representatives it is agreed that this was not an unsafe situation but it is also agreed that cars already in the fast lane have priority. It is also noted, however, that the stationary car 90, on seeing car 32 nosing into the fast lane ahead of him, moved forward to close the gap. The Stewards consider that this to be a mitigating factor in this case and therefore consider no further action to be appropriate.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
