1. Balance of Performance

In accordance with Article 30.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, the Stewards confirm that the Balance of Performance document applicable for this competition is the document bearing the header:

2. Starting Procedure

The Stewards remind all competitors and officials that in accordance with Article 45.11d) of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and the Covid-19 Protocol for this event, with no grid walk taking place, a shortened starting procedure has been stipulated for the race.

The timing of the starting procedure will be as detailed in the published Official Detailed Timetable for the event.

3. Minimum Pit Stop Time for Pro-Am Category

In accordance with Article 20.6 of the GT Challenge Europe Sporting Regulations, the minimum pit stop time from pit in to pit out for Pro-Am category entries at this competition will be:

77.00 seconds

4. Conversion of Drive-Through and Stop-and-Go Penalties to Time Penalties

In accordance with Article 16.5 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, the time penalty which will be applied in the case of any drive-through or stop-and-go penalty notified close to the end of, or after, the races at this competition will be as follows:

Drive-Through Penalty: will be converted to 45 seconds added to the elapsed time of the car.

Stop-and-Go Penalty: will be converted to 50 seconds plus the prescribed stop time added to the elapsed time of the car.

5. Parc Fermé

Parc Fermé after Qualifying and the Races will be in the respective pit garages, with each car nose towards the pit lane, except for those cars selected for Scrutineering by the Technical Delegate which must be pushed to the Technical Scrutineering area.
