SUPERPOLE TIMETABLE

At 18:00 the Superpole session will go Green and the pit lane light will be green. At this time all cars admitted to the Superpole must be in front of their garages, either at 45 degrees or parallel.

Teams may fit their tyres when they wish.

After completing their laps and in lap, the cars will come back to the pit lane and will be in parc fermé conditions in the F1 pit lane, with the first car stopping before the podium, lining up three by three. After the final car comes in, a number of cars will be selected and pushed back to Technical Scrutineering under parc fermé conditions. All remaining cars may be pushed by their teams to their garage where they will remain in parc fermé conditions. The top three drivers and the leading Pro and Pro-Am drivers, should they not be in the top three, must proceed to the Press Conference which will take place in the Media Centre.
