The Stewards notify all competitors and officials of the following:

1. Balance of Performance

In accordance with Article 30.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, the Stewards confirm that the Balance of Performance document applicable for this competition is the document bearing the header:

“BALANCE OF PERFORMANCE FOR TRACKS CATEGORY C”

and the title:

**“BALANCE OF PERFORMANCE FOR TRACKS CATEGORY C :
NÜRBURGRING, BARCELONA”**

and identified by the footer:

“Decisions taken by the SRO GT Bureau 01/10/2021”

This document is available on the 'Teams' area of the Fanatec GT World Challenge Europe powered by AWS website.

2. Refuelling Connection Time Restrictions and Penalties

In accordance with Articles 20.1 and 20.2 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, there will be a restriction on the length of refuelling (i.e. the time that the fuel nozzle is connected to the car) during each of the mandatory pit stops in the race at this competition. This restriction is confirmed below and is in accordance with the Balance of Performance applicable to this competition.

For each mandatory pit stop: The minimum refuelling connection time, for all cars, is 37 seconds.

There is a one-second tolerance on the minimum refuelling connection time, which may be used once during the race, in accordance with Article 20.1 of the above regulations.

There are no time restrictions on any non-mandatory pit stops.

Penalties: The penalties for any car which fails to abide by the above minimum refuelling connection time, will be as follows:

1 st offence:	A stop-and-go penalty
2 nd offence:	A 30-seconds stop-and-go penalty

3. Conversion of Drive-Through and Stop-and-Go Penalties to Time Penalties

In accordance with Article 16.5 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, the time penalty which will be applied in the case of any drive-through or stop-and-go penalty notified close to the end of, or after, the races at this competition will be as follows:


Drive-Through Penalty: will be converted to **30 seconds** added to the elapsed time of the car.


Stop-and-Go Penalty: will be converted to **35 seconds plus the prescribed stop time** added to the elapsed time of the car.

4. Parc Fermé

Parc Fermé after Qualifying and the Race will be in the respective pit garages, with each car nose towards the pit lane, except for those cars selected for Scrutineering by the Technical Delegate which must be pushed to the Technical Scrutineering area.
