Fact:

The competitor has requested permission to carry over additional tyres from the Spa

event for use during Free Practice and Pre-Qualifying at this competition.

Offence:

Breach of Article 29.7 and 29.8 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS

Sporting Regulations

Decision:

The competitor's request is denied. No additional tyres may be carried over.

Reason:

The competitor has requested permission for an additional set of tyres for each of cars 34 and 35 to be carried over from the Spa event (above the two sets permitted by Article 29.8) due to unusually high tyre degradation at the Nurburgring event. Having heard from the competitor's representative, and having consulted the Series Technical Director and

the Pirelli representative, the Stewards do not consider there to be any special

circumstances affecting this particular competitor which justify making an exception to

the Sporting Regulations. The competitor's request is therefore denied.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
