- For a test or an issue contact the Pit Lane manager Ghislain VERRIEST




























ELECTRONIC BOARD ON THE LINE


































PIT LANE





STOP AND GO – TIME PENALTY is in front of your pit garage, controlled by the team



























START OF SESSION 45°






























PIT STOP AND RACES

































FAST LANE OPEN



- Max 5' before session.
- On the timing monitors and RD radio
- Cars allowed to Pit Exit
- Not for the race
- In case of Red flag Stop in front of your Pit No cars in the fast lane

PARC - FERME

After last Q session and the race - Inside the pit garages (no skates)

Except for podium cars and cars selected by scrutineering










System OK and stand by

GREEN Flag - On during 10 Seconds

IN CAR MARSHALLING SYSTEM





FCY in 20 Seconds



Countdown FCY in 10 - 9 - 8 - 7 - 6 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1 NO OVERTAKING



(Yellow Blinking) - FCY NOW - 80 Km / Hr



SAFETY CAR



End of SC procedure - ON during 10 seconds No passing before the line



























Speed 80 Km/Hr – NO weaving (Zig Zag)

FCY followed by SC except during the three 1st laps where it will directly SC

SC gets the leader during the FCY

Countdown 20 seconds – marshalling system

- At 10 sec boards & lights No overtaking
- At 0 sec yellow flags & all cars at 80 Km/Hr
- RESTART on short notice 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 GREEN



























SAFETY CAR (SC)



- The SC will come on track during the FCY without lights.
- SC gets the leader. If necessary it will overtake cars.
- No weaving, to avoid contact while the SC is overtaking

"SC procedure"





- the SC will turn on its lights, all marshal posts will swap the FCY boards to SC
- All cars, in single file, must increase their speed to catch up the group
- End of procedure: "SC in this lap"

"SC lights off" – all signalling removed

"Green" – no overtaking prior to pass the line

























SC & FCY



For FCY and SC procedures (only), the in car marshalling system has priority on the marshal posts signals Green included




























PIT EXIT LIGHTS DURING SC



Pit exit light remain **GREEN**

When the SC will pass the FINISH LINE, the pit exit light will turn

When last car in the group behind SC passes pit exit, the light will turn **GREEN** again



RED FLAG PROCEDURE





Slow down to 80 Km/Hr - NO overtaking

Free practices: Clock will NOT stop - drive to pit lane

Qualifying: Clock stops - lap time cancelled - drive to pit lane

Race: - Clock will NOT stop - line up red line

- Order as when the red flag was declared

- Parc-Fermé conditions - on the grid teams and officials ONLY

- Restart behind SC

If you enter the pits after the red flag: restart one lap later





















BLUE FLAG





At ALL TIMES: displayed to a driver leaving the pits if traffic is approaching on the track.

During PRACTICE: a faster car is close behind you and is about to overtake you.

During the RACE: shown to a car about to be lapped, the driver concerned must allow the following car to pass at the earliest opportunity.




















