The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 26. / Nicolas Baert  
**Competitor:** Sainteloc Junior Team  
**Time (fact):** 16:45 hrs  
**Session:** Race 2  
**Fact:** Collision between cars 26 and 18 at Turn 3  
**Regulation::** Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** **No further action**  
**Reason:** There was a collision between cars 26 and 18 at turn 3, with both cars stopping and continuing. Having summoned and heard from the competitor's representative and having viewed TV footage evidence, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
