The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 87 / Casper Stevenson and 54 / Christian Engelhart
Competitor: AKKODIS ASP Team and Dinamic Motosport
Time (fact): 16:45 hrs
Session: Race 2
Fact: Collision between cars 87 and 54 at Turn 5
Regulation:: Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code
Decision: **No further action**
Reason: There was a collision between cars 87 and 54 at turn 5 on the first racing lap, with car 54 retiring as a consequence. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV footage and on-board video evidence, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
