The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 87 / Thomas Druet
Competitor: AKKODIS ASP Team
Time (fact): 17:31 hrs
Session: Race 2
Fact: Collision between cars 87 and 33 at turn 2
Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code
Decision: **Time penalty 5-seconds added to the elapsed race time of car 87 and 1 Behaviour Warning Point to the driver**
Reason: Car 87 collided with the rear of car 33 at turn 2, with car 33 spinning and losing 4 positions. Having summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative and having viewed TV footage and on-board video from car 87, the Stewards consider that driver 87 was predominantly responsible for causing the collision and impose the penalty above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
