Fact:

A team member signed as the driver on the Drivers' Briefing Sign On Sheet.

Offence:

Breach of Article 15.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting

Regulations and Article 12.2.1.c of the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision:

Fine of €500 (Five Hundred Euros) to the Competitor.

Reason:

The driver failed to attend the Drivers' Briefing but a team member signed the Sign On sheet as the driver. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, it is accepted that the signature is not the driver's, who says when he realised he would be delayed he asked the team to sign on his behalf. The Stewards consider this to be a case of fraudulent conduct by a team member and therefore determine that this is a breach of the above regulations. Accordingly, they impose a financial penalty on the

competitor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
