The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined timekeeping data and the competitor's telemetry evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 87 / Casper Stevenson  
**Competitor:** AKKODIS ASP Team  
**Time (fact):** 20:01 hrs  
**Session:** Pre-Qualifying  
**Fact:** Car 87 set a fastest sector 2 and fastest lap time under a yellow flag  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 33.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2.5.5.b of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix H  
**Decision:** **Reprimand and 1 Behaviour Warning Point**  
**Reason:** Car 87 set a fastest sector 2 time and fastest lap while a yellow flag was displayed at turn 12. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, and having considered the competitor's telemetry evidence, the Stewards understand that this lap time was set on new tyres compared to previous laps on old tyres. Whilst the Stewards accept the driver's explanation that he took some action in response to the yellow flag, they are not satisfied that this was sufficient to comply with the specific requirements of Article 2.5.5.b. They therefore impose a Reprimand and a Behaviour Warning Point in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
