The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 18 / Gerhard Tweraser
Competitor: GSM Novamarine
Time (fact): 15:15 hrs
Session: Qualifying 1
Fact: A computer was connected to car 18 during Qualifying 1
Offence: Breach of Article 41.7.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations
Decision: **All lap times set by car 18 prior to the time of this incident are deleted. Car 18 is authorised to start Race 1 from the last position on the grid.**
Reason: A team member connected a laptop computer to car 18 after one fast lap had been completed in Qualifying 1. The car was then pushed into the garage and took no further part in the session. Having heard from the competitor's representative, it is admitted that a computer was connected in order to analyse an ABS issue and accepted that this was a breach of the above regulation. The Stewards therefore impose a penalty as specified in that regulation. Noting that no other qualification lap times were set by this car, but that suitable times were set during Free Practice and Pre-Qualifying, the Stewards authorise car 18 to start Race 1 from the last position on the grid.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
