

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined timekeeping data, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 54 / Christian Engelhart
Competitor: Dinamic Motorsport
Time (fact): 09:55 hrs
Session: Qualifying 2
Fact: Car 54 set a fastest sector 3 and fastest lap time while yellow flags were shown
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 33.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2.5.5.b of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix H
Decision: **No further action**
Reason: Car 54 set a fastest sector 3 time and fastest lap while a yellow flag was displayed at turn 16. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, and having viewed on-board camera footage, the Stewards accept that the driver slowed in response to the yellow flags and did not fully accelerate onto the start/finish straight (thereby compromising his next lap also). They therefore determine that the driver complied with the requirements of the above regulations and take no further action in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
