The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined timekeeping data, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 52 / Andrea Bertolini

Competitor: AF Corse

Time (fact): 09:55 hrs

Session: Qualifying 2

Fact: Car 52 set a fastest sector 3 and fastest lap time while yellow flags were shown

Offence: Breach of Article 33.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2.5.5.b of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix H

Decision: **Drop of 3 grid positions for Race 2 and 1 Behaviour Warning Point**

Reason: Car 52 set a fastest sector 3 time and fastest lap while a yellow flag was displayed at turn 16. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, the Stewards accept that the driver slowed initially in response to the yellow flag but the driver admits that having passed the incident he fully accelerated before passing a green flag in order not to compromise the following lap. The Stewards consider that the driver must respect the yellow flag requirements throughout the full yellow sector as there may be other issues the driver is not aware of, and determine that this is a breach of the above regulations.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
