The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors, representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Nos. / Drivers: 66 / Dennis Marschall and 88 / Maximilian Götz

Competitors: Attempto Racing and AKKODIS ASP Team

Time (fact): 09:59 hrs

Session: Qualifying 2

Fact: Alleged impeding between cars 66 and 88

Offence:: Alleged breach of Article 41.9 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2e) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: There was alleged impeding between cars 66 and 88 at turn 13. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed on-board video evidence from both cars, the Stewards consider this to be an unfortunate situation but determine that neither driver was responsible for impeding. They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
