The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:


No. / Driver: 86 / Igor Walilko
Competitor: AKKODIS ASP Team
Time (fact): 15:02 hrs
Session: Race 2
Fact: Collision between cars 86 and 30 at turn 5
Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2 d) of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix L Chapter IV

Decision: **Warning**

Reason: Car 86 made slight contact with the rear of car 30 at the exit of turn 5, causing a left rear puncture. Having heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives, the Stewards consider that, having run wide and attempted to 'cut back' at the exit, driver 86 made a minor misjudgement, resulting in very slight contact with car 30 who had passed to the inside. The Stewards consider this to be a case of close racing and impose only a Warning in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
