

The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No. / Driver:** 21 / Alessandro Balzan  
**Competitor:** AF Corse  
**Time (fact):** 12:21 hrs  
**Session:** Qualifying 3  
**Fact:** Unsafe release of car 21  
**Offence:** Breach of Article 34.16 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and of Article 12.2.1.h of the FIA International Sporting Code  
**Decision:** **Fine of €500 (Five Hundred Euros)**  
**Reason:** Car 21 was released from its working area, causing a collision with car 83 which was already in the fast lane. Car 21 incurred damage, though car 83 did not. Having heard from the competitor's representative and having viewed TV footage, the competitor accepts that this is a clear breach of the above regulation and the Stewards impose a financial penalty.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
