Regulation::

Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations

and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision:

No further action

Reason:

Cars 188 and 7 made contact at turn 14, with car 188 spinning as a consequence. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV and on-board video evidence, the Stewards consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. They therefore

determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.
