L Chapter IV.

Decision:

No further action

Reason:

It was alleged that car 63 impeded car 12 at turn 15. Having heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed on-board video evidence from car 12, the Stewards accept that car 63 aborted his lap and slowed due to yellow flags in sectors 1 and 2 and was preparing for a further attempt at a fast lap, in the expectation that car 12 behind was doing likewise. The Stewards note that car 12 closed right up to car 63 at turn 15 but do not consider this case to be a breach of the above regulations by car 63.

They therefore determine that no further action is appropriate.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
