Alleged causing a collision with car 2

Offence:

Alleged breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS

Sporting Regulations and Article 2d) of the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision:

No further action

Reason:

Car 26 and car 2 collided at turn 5 on lap 1 of the race, with car 2 retiring as a consequence. Having heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV footage and on-board video, the Stewards note that both cars moved towards each other in a close pack of cars and consider that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for causing the collision. They therefore determine that no

further action is appropriate in this case.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
