- Crossed the white line at pit lane: entry exit
- Exceeded the speed limit in the pit lane with a speed of km /h
- Did not respect yellow flags repeatedly
- Did not respect track limits repeatedly
- Made a false start
- Caused a collision
- Forced a driver off the track
- Illegitimately impeded another driver during overtaking

Reason: Whilst a report from the timekeepers indicated an improvement in time in sector 1 whilst a yellow flag was being displayed for an incident at turn1, it was noted that the FCY signals had just been energised as car 111 negotiated turn1 and the driver responded and immediately slowed once the car exited the corner.
