The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determined the following:

Car No: 12 & 111 Driver: Luca Ghiotto and Petryk Krupinski

Facts:

- Crossed the white line at pit lane: entry exit
- Exceeded the speed limit in the pit lane with a speed of km/h
- Did not respect yellow flags repeatedly
- Did not respect track limits repeatedly
- Made a false start
- Caused a collision – allegation.
- Forced a driver off the track
- Illegitimately impeded another driver during overtaking
- Pit lane infringement:

Offence:

- Alleged breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations
- Alleged breach of App. L Ch. IV of the FIA International Sporting Code
