

SPORTING NOTE #8 – 29/06/2022
BEHAVIOUR WARNING POINTS

Please note the following correction to article 17 – Behaviour Warning Points.

Due to the fact that points are no longer subtracted for events during which no additional points are gained, the following correction is made :

[...]

- A driver with 3 points will receive a drop of 5 grid positions for the car in which he is driving for the next race
- A driver with 4 points will receive a drop of 10 grid positions for the car in which he is driving for the next race
- A driver with 5 points or more will receive a minimum of a drive-through penalty for the car in which he is driving, to be applied at the next race.

After these penalties have been imposed and the penalty has been taken, ~~the driver will have 3 Behaviour Warning Points deducted from their score and the remainder will be carried forward to the next Competition in which the driver takes part.~~ **the driver's score will be reset to zero.**

Behaviour Warning Points will be carried forward to the next Event of the Endurance Cup or the Sprint Cup respectively. Points and/or penalties will not be carried forward between Sprint and Endurance Events.




