The Stewards have received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Driver and car No: Casper Stevenson #87

Competitor: AKKODIS ASP Team

Time (fact): 15.30hrs

Session: Race 2

Fact: Cars #87 #159 and #86 collided at T9

Offence: Article 33.4 of Fanatec World Challenge Europe 2022 Sporting Regulations (the Regulations)

Decision: 10 seconds added to race time and 1 BWP

Reason: Video footage from the TV live stream showed cars #87 and #159 leaving the track at T9. When these two cars rejoined there was a collision between #87 #159 and #86. The Stewards are satisfied that there is no fault on the part of the driver of car #86 but hold the drivers of both #87 and #159 for unsafely rejoining the track and the resultant collision with car #86.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting, within the applicable time limits.
