Offence: Breach of Article 25 of Fanatec World Challenge Europe 2022 Sporting Regulations

Decision: No Penalty

The Stewards instruct the Competitor that the driver must be briefed by the Team Manager in the content of the Drivers Briefing before he undertakes any track activity.

Reason: The Team Representative explained the driver, a gentleman driver, had been at the circuit and took part in the Bronze Test on Tuesday 26th July but had to return to Germany for a business meeting today. The Stewards accept these reasons as force majeure.
