Drop of 3 grid positions for car 21 for the Race and 1 Behaviour Warning Point to

the driver

Reason:

Car 21 set an improved sector 1 time while yellow flags were displayed at turn 1. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, the driver accepts that he did not slow sufficiently in response to the yellow flag. The Stewards consider this to be a

matter of safety and impose the penalty above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
