Session: Qualifying & Night Practice


Fact: The competitor has requested permission to take part in the Race as the drivers of car 911 were unable to set a lap time in Qualifying or participate in Night Practice due to heavy damage following a crash,

Regulations: Article 41.5 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations


Decision: **Car 911 is permitted to start the Race from a grid position determined in accordance with Articles 41.5 and 43.2 of the Sporting Regulations**

Reason: Due to the damage incurred in this instance, the Stewards consider the circumstances to be a case of force majeure as provided for within the above regulations. Noting that all three drivers set appropriate lap times during the Bronze Test, Practice and Pre-Qualifying sessions and all are experienced endurance race drivers, the Stewards give permission for the car to participate in the Race at this competition.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
