The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 163 / Mattia Michelotto

Competitor: Vincenzo Sospiri Racing

Time (fact): 21:27 hrs

Session: Qualifying 2

Fact: Car 163 collided with car 20 at turn 18

Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2d) of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix L Chapter IV

Decision: **Drop of 5 grid positions for car 163 for the Race and 1 Behaviour Warning Point to the driver**

Reason: Car 163 collided with car 20 at turn 18 causing car 20 to spin. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, the Stewards consider that driver 163 was responsible for causing the collision. They also determine that this is aggravated by the fact that the cars passed a waved yellow flag at the marshal post before the collision, which the driver says he did not see. Accordingly, they impose the penalty above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
