The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 52 / Louis Machiels

Competitor: AF Corse

Time (fact): 13:45 hrs

Session: Pre-Qualifying

Fact: Collision between cars 52 and 56 at turn 8

Offence: Breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations, Article 12.2.1.j of the FIA International Sporting Code and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the Code

Decision: **Reprimand and 1 Behaviour Warning Point**

Reason: Cars 52 and 56 collided at turn 8, as a result of which car 56 spun and continued. Having heard from the drivers and the competitors' representatives and having viewed on-board video from car 52, it is accepted that driver 52 was predominantly responsible for causing the collision. Whilst both parties consider this a minor incident, the Stewards determine that this is a breach of the above regulations and, noting that no competitive advantage was gained during Pre-Qualifying, impose a Reprimand and 1 BWP.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
