Decision:

No further action

Reason:

Car 111 set faster sector 1 times while yellow flags were being displayed. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative and having viewed timekeeping data, the Stewards note that the times set were on new tyres immediately after the pit stop, with minimal difference between them. They accept the driver's explanation of his response to the yellow flags and determine that no further action is appropriate in this

instance.
