The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined timekeeping data, summoned and heard from the driver and the competitor's representative, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No. / Driver: 111 / Christian Klein
Competitor: JP Motorsport
Time (fact): 14:28, 14:30, 14:31 and 14:33 hrs
Session: Race 1
Fact: Car 111 set faster sector times while yellow flags were being displayed
Offence: Alleged breach of Article 33.1 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Article 2.5.5.b of the FIA International Sporting Code Appendix H
Decision: **No further action**
Reason: Car 111 set faster sector 1 times while yellow flags were being displayed. Having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative and having viewed timekeeping data, the Stewards note that the times set were on new tyres immediately after the pit stop, with minimal difference between them. They accept the driver's explanation of his response to the yellow flags and determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
