The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from the drivers and the competitor's representatives, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

**Nos. / Drivers:** 21 / Cedric Sbirrazzuoli and 188 / Dean Macdonald

**Competitors:** AF Corse and Garage 59

**Time (fact):** 14:43 hrs

**Session:** Race 1


**Fact:** Collision between cars 21 and 188 at Turn 6

**Regulation::** Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

**Decision:** **No further action**

**Reason:** Cars 21 and 188 made contact at turn 6 with both cars continuing. Having summoned and heard from both drivers and competitors' representatives and having viewed TV and on-board video evidence, all parties are agreed that neither driver was wholly or predominantly responsible for the collision. The Stewards therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.
