The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, having heard from the driver and the competitor's representative of car 53, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

Nos. / Drivers: 99 / Alex Aka and 53 / Ulysse de Pauw

Competitors: Attempto Racing and AF Corse

Time (fact): 14:35 hrs

Session: Race 2


Fact: Reported collision between cars 99 and 53 at Turn 11

Regulation:: Alleged breach of Article 33.4 of the Fanatec GT Challenge Europe powered by AWS Sporting Regulations and Chapter IV Article 2d) of Appendix L to the FIA International Sporting Code

Decision: **No further action**

Reason: It was reported that cars 99 and 53 collided at turn 11, resulting in car 53 spinning. However, having heard from the driver and competitor's representative of car 53, the driver explains that there was no contact with 99 and that he made a mistake and spun on his own. The Stewards therefore determine that no further action is appropriate in this instance.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 15 of the FIA International Sporting Code, within the applicable time limits.
